Action 01- Children and Teens Painting up to **July 15th.** - Sending the Patches up to **July 30th.**

. Each child and adolescent paints a piece of material expressing their experience: sensations, visualization, ideas, and wishes of peace —instructions in the Protocol.

. Schools, institutions, projects, and community groups leading the local painting activities send the patches to one of the addresses listed in the Protocol up to July 30th to compose the Country/Continental Flag.

Goal > diversity: participation of children and adolescents from many ethnic, religious, and cultural traditions, immigrants, refugees, those in war situations, hospitals, youth institutions, and with special needs.

Action 02 - Assembling the Flag by **August 15th.** - Sending to NY up to **September 7th.**

. The World City Organization will gather all the painted pieces from its local and continental networks in a Regional Peace Flag that will form the World Flag for Peace and Global Friendship.

-Suggestion 01: Walk the Flag > Display the Peace Flag in a Public Park Walk before sending it to NYC

. Sending it to New York up to **September 7th, 2025.**

Goal: Celebrations: celebrate the gifts of life, honor our roots and traditions, and share beyond words the joy of cocreating with fellows from all over the planet.

Action 03: Edit Recordings of the Painting Process plus Comments > Send by **August 30th.**

. Each organization, project, or community group sends an edited video on the children's painting and comments to weconglobal@gmail.com, authorizing its publication by the Festival. Editing instructions can be found in the Protocol.

-Suggestion 02: Organize a Video Exhibit through a digital platform to allow participants from other cities and countries to see the results of their co-creation. The videos from the exhibit will be publicized on the World City Organization website and [YouTube.com/user/peaceglobalnet](https://www.youtube.com/user/peaceglobalnet).

Goal: Widespread the impact of the collaborative creation to a larger number of people. Make the richness of children's/teens' experiences of Painting Peace available in a public format.
